Pfc. James Patrick Carney, Jr., USMC -KIA Quang Nam 2/27/69

Dear Marines and former Marines of F Company, 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines,

My name is John Sanders. I am helping the mother of Pfc. James Patrick Carney, Jr., USMC, find and hopefully communicate with marines who knew and or served with her son, who was killed on 2/27/69 at Quang Nam, Viet Nam while serving with F Company, 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines. Pfc. Carney, as best we can determine was killed only about one month following his arrival in Nam. His MOS was 35 I (Assaultman). He was a native of Naugatuck, CT. If you knew or served with Pfc. It is currently on display outside the palace that is now home to the 4th Infantry division. It will eventually be shipped and shown at the memorial museum in Fort Hood, Texas.


